To the full extent permitted by law, I agree on behalf of the player and in my own right, to absolve, indemnify and keep indemnified CA, CNSW, NSJCA & NSDCC and their directors, officers, employees, volunteers sponsors and agents involved in administering cricket against all costs, losses or damages however caused arising from or in relation to the player's participation in cricket, and to waive, release and forever discharge CA, CNSW, NSJCA & NSDCC and their directors, officers, employees, volunteers sponsors and agents involved in administering cricket from all claims and/or causes of action that I or the player have or may have (including for negligence) arising from any injury, loss or damage to any property arising directly or indirectly out of the player's participation in cricket.

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REGISTRATION INFORMATION

There are many hours of volunteer labour involved in collating all of the information to register approximately 300 players, so your assistance is sought to make the jobs of our the volunteers as easy as possible.

You can assist in the following ways:

- Ensuring the registration form is completed as fully as possible
- Including your child's **MyCricket ID** on the form. If they played last season, you can obtain their ID by going to www.nsjca.asn.au and selecting MyCricket from the main menu. Then select Statistics, Batting, Batting Averages. Select last season (2009-10) from the drop-down menu and your child's division last season. Click on player to sort the list alphabetically, then click on your child's name, which will bring up all their statistics from last season, but also reveal their MyCricket ID.
- Paying for registration (and shirt if applicable) via EFT if possible.
- In Under 11s and 12s, indicating your preference to play SAT AM or SAT PM/SUN AM (refer private school sport below).

Time and duration of matches

For Under 10s and up, the competition starts on 18/19 September 2010. Under 9s and our Milo in2cricket program start on 16 October 2010. The matches in the various age groups are usually scheduled as follows:

Under 9: Saturday mornings either 8.00am – 10.00am or 10.15am – 12.15pm

Under 10: Saturday mornings usually 8.30am to approx 11.15am.

Under 11 SAT AM or SUN AM competition Sat or Sunday mornings usually 8.15am – to approx 12 Noon. No SAT PM in 2010-11

Under 12 AM competition Saturday mornings usually 8.15am – to approx 12.15pm

Under 12 PM Competition Saturday afternoons 2.00pm to around 6.00pm

Under 13 & Under 14 Saturday afternoons 2.00pm to around 6.00pm. Generally some 2- day matches 2.00pm – 5.30pm

Under 14/15s Sunday mornings 8:30am to around 12:30pm.

Under 16/17s Sunday mornings on turf wickets (subject to availability) 8.00am – 12.15pm.

Private school sport

Parents/guardians are asked to be cognisant of any school sport commitments that your child has or will have after Christmas if attending a private school next year. If your child falls into this category and is in Under 11s or 12s where there are SAT AM and SAT PM or SUN AM competitions, they will usually be placed in a SAT PM or SUN AM team if there are places available. To the extent possible, the club will try to avoid a team being left short of players for the second half of the season due to school sport obligations.

Where you have stated a preference for SAT AM, SAT PM or SUN AM and you have listed friends your child wishes to play with, the AM/PM will be the first basis used to allocate players to teams. We will still try to place friends in teams together provided they have specified the same time.

Age Dispensations

Girls may play in the age group below the one they would be in based on their date of birth. That is, if they would be in the Under 11s based on their age, they may play in the Under 10s. This is an automatic dispensation.

It is possible for a child to obtain a dispensation to play in an age group younger than the one they should be in based on medical or skill grounds. Please contact the registrar if you wish to know more. Enquiries will be treated in confidence.
